To: All SBTC Disaster Relief Volunteers and Leaders

RE: Potential South Texas Rain/Flood Event and Hurricane Florence

Alert/Standby Status for Hurricane Florence

We continue at alert status for Hurricane Florence. Flooding is ongoing and many roads closed in North and South Carolina. Some rivers have yet to crest.

Standby: We will be sending Recovery Units (mudout) to South Carolina on Monday, September 23, 2018 (possible delay due to cresting rivers/road closures). Feeding volunteers will accompany the Recovery Units.

Deployment Structure: 2 days travel; 8 days work/ministry; two days travel for a total of a 12 day deployment. Unit Directors please contact your Task Force Directors.

I still anticipate a request for feeding volunteers to staff the large mass care kitchens that are deployed to North Carolina and South Carolina. North Carolina is anticipating need of shower and laundry units. We are still waiting for request.

We stand ready to respond to any request that comes from the hurricane zone. For the moment, be ready by checking your equipment, your calendar, and pray for the victims of Florence.
