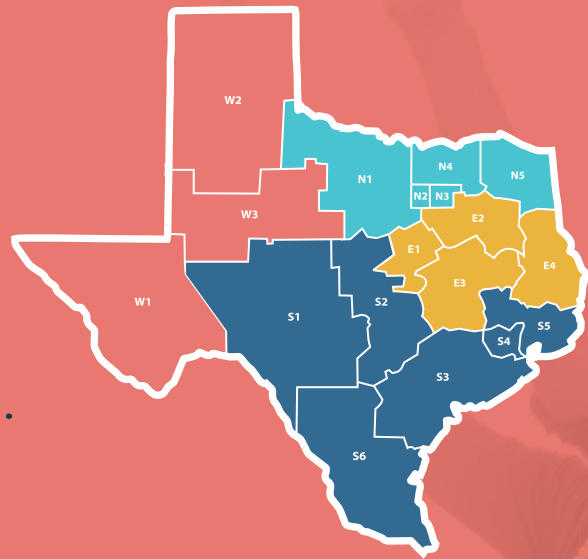
Monica LeDezma
